**October 30, 2017 at 1-5pm (Lunch is on your own):** We will meet at a location to be determined soon. We will spend the day on the Deer Ridge Conservation Area in Lewis county where we will review forest management and research including silviculture to regenerate oak, restore woodlands, manage riparian forests, group selection harvesting, site preparation burning, etc. We will have presentations by managers from Iowa on their forest management practices and issues as well as an update on the reorganization of forestry in Iowa. Both active and long-term examples of management and research will be presented. We will address issues of bat conservation and impacts to forest management.

**October 30, 2017:** Overnight accommodations in Kirksville, MO will be at the Days Inn, 3805 S. Baltimore, Kirksville, MO 63501 where we have a block of 45 rooms at the rate of \$79.79 TAX EXEMPT.
